



## How do I unlink a map point from a well file?

1. Go to **Applications** on the Main Application Bar, select **Mapping**.
2. Right Click on a **Map Point** with the cursor and select **Unlink from Well**. (If **Unlink from Well** does not appear this means that the **Map Point** is not linked to a well). It may be easier to identify the wells if you post well names on the map and zoom in if necessary. (To post names, Click on **Post points** on the power bar and Check the **Names** box under **Annotation** and Click **Close**. To zoom in, Click on **Zoom In** on the power bar move the cursor next to the **Map Point** and Click once, move the cursor again to “draw” a box around the **Map Point/s** and Click once again. You will now be zoomed into that area. To zoom out Click the **Zoom Out** button on the power bar).
3. You will be prompted with a message asking you if you are sure you want to remove the link, Click **Ok**. The **Map Point** will now change colour from green to red. Press **F5** on your keyboard if this does not happen automatically.

This procedure can be done in many places throughout the program. For example, in:

- **Applications/Mapping/Post Points**
- **Applications/Correlation/Panel Display/Map Options on the power bar**

Other Correlation module options like:

- **Wells for Panel**
- **Zig-Zag**
- **Projected**
- **Spider Display**
- **Downhole Section**
